

# Overnight & Discipleship Camp

## Packing List

*\*\* Recommend packing all belongings inside a flat storage container, to store under bunk beds easily. Suitcases/duffles are permitted.*

- 12 disposable water bottles
- Sleeping Bag or Twin size sheets and Comforter/Blanket
- Pillow
- Jacket/Sweatshirt (it gets chilly at camp in the evenings)
- 5 T-Shirts/Tank tops (NO spaghetti straps, tube tops, crop-tops, oversized arm holes etc.)
- 5 pair of shorts (Fingertip length or longer)
- Blue jeans / long pants for riding (4) -- no low rise, no bell bottoms or leggings
- Socks (at least 7 pair) /Underwear
- Raincoat or poncho
- Rainboots/Muck boots (optional for rainy days)
- Swimsuits (girls, one piece or full length tankinis only) Boys (no bikini or low waist)
- Pajamas (at least 2)
- Bath Towel (2) & Pool Towel (2)
- Laundry/Dirty Clothes Bag
- Sneakers (2)
- **\*\*Riding Boots:** Campers ARE able to ride in tennis shoes, but please no hiking style boots or extremely thick/rigid bottoms. The smoother the better!
- Water shoes or sandals/crocs
- Bible (if you don't have one, we do!)
- Toiletries-- Hairbrush, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Body Wash, Shampoo, etc.
- Carrier for Toiletries (to transport to and from the bathhouse)
- Small backpack/drawstring bag to carry clothes/towel to and from bathhouse
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray

### **\*\* Optional \*\***

- Food (campers with special dietary needs should bring supplemental items to be stored in townhall refrigerator/freezer.)
- Ball cap, sunglasses, flashlight
- Fishing rod and gear
- (Very helpful) **50 LB. bag of horse feed** (sweet feed or oats) from local feed store, tractor supply or Sam's Club

**\*\*Store Spending Money:** Must be paid during the registration process or BEFORE start of camp week by calling 724-483-4343 or adding online. *Any remaining balance at the end of camp week will be donated (camper's choice) to Horse Care or Missions*

### What NOT to bring

1. ABSOLUTELY **No Cell Phones** *\*As of 2022 this also applies to Teen Discipleship*
2. **Food (campers with special dietary needs should bring supplemental items to be stored in townhall refrigerator/freezer.)**
  - a. ***\*\*Teen Discipleship may bring food/snack items to be stored in Discipleship kitchen***
3. Shirts with inappropriate, negative and/or questionable slogans or prints.
4. Electronics (music players, video games, digital camera, smart watches (fit bits ARE permitted))
5. Drugs, Alcohol, Tobacco, Matches, Lighters, Stick tattoo or piercing kits, hair-dye
6. Fireworks
7. Weapons of any kind (knives, guns, razor blades etc.)
8. Dresses, short shorts or shirts, low cut or revealing tank tops
9. Medicine of any kind without completed **"Medication Administration Records"**
